

Pharmacy Technician Program

The Pharmacy Technician course prepares you with entry-level skills for employment in pharmacies.

Prerequisites for the Pharmacy Technician program include the following: the ability to periodically lift 35lbs; computer operation knowledge is helpful, but not required. A current immunization record (proof of vaccination of measles, mumps, rubella and varicella), and a negative tuberculosis test are to be provided on the 1st day of class. Once enrolled, students will be required to have a drug test administered at a facility assigned by Baldy View ROP at the student's expense.

Requirements:

- High School students must be in the 12th grade.
- Adults must show proof of high school diploma or GED.
