

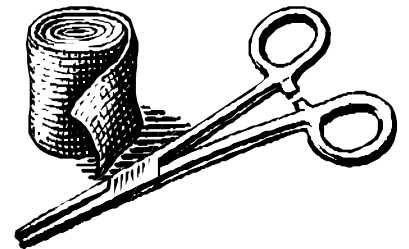


California Sports Medicine Careers Challenge

Six Baldy View ROP students enrolled in the Sports Medicine class at Chino Hills High School competed in the competition sponsored by Alert Services, Inc.

Each student was required to turn in a portfolio and they competed in their own specialty which included taping, injury evaluation scenario, anatomy, terminology, CPR, and presentation.

Two students won awards: Marco Sanchez from Chino Hills High School placed second in the injury evaluation scenario and Jessica Corsaro of Claremont High School placed first in the presentation event. The judge commented that Ms. Corsaro's presentation was the best presentation that he had seen in 13 years of judging the event.
