

## Teaching at Baldy View ROP

Baldy View ROP offers instruction in many occupational areas. The ROP program is a state supported educational service that provides job training and job search training to California residents who are 16 years of age and older. ROP programs offer instruction in many areas including:

- Health Careers
- Business and Marketing Careers
- Public Service Careers
- Industry and Technology Careers

All certificated staff must have a valid Designated Subjects California teaching credential. To apply for a Designated Subjects California teaching credential an applicant must:

- Provide verification of the equivalent of five years of full-time work experience in a vocational field recognized by the State of California Commission on Teacher Credentialing. (48 semester post secondary units, directly related to the subject, may be used to equal up to two years of experience.) One of those years of experience must be within the last three years.
- Provide verification of high school graduation or equivalency (G.E.D.).
- Submit an application (including fees and above listed verifications). A five-year preliminary credential will be issued upon verification of completion of the U.S. Constitution. If this requirement has not been met at the time of application, the preliminary credential will be issued for only one year. Within this first year, the applicant must verify successful completion of the U.S. Constitution requirement in order to apply for the remaining four years of the preliminary credential.

The credential will authorize you to teach in vocational (ROP) courses as well as adult education classes.
