The cosmetician, also referred to as a esthetician, performs a variety of skin care procedures. Services include skin analysis, proper skin care, facials, massage, make-up application, lash and brow tints, and waxing.

The cosmetician course consists of six hundred clock hours of technical instruction and practical operations covering all practices constituting the art of a cosmetician.

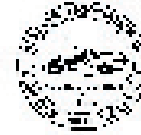
