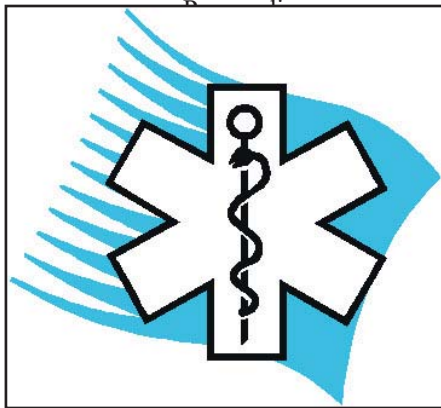

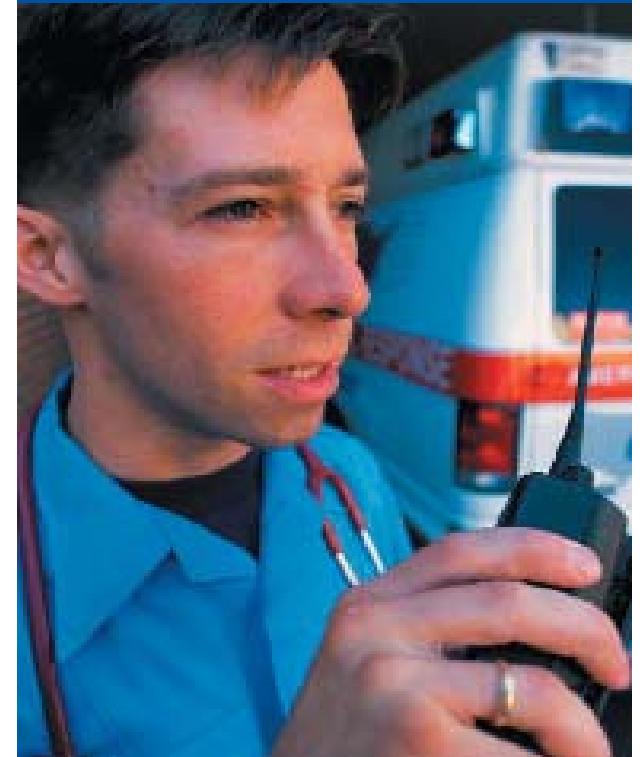

# EMERGENCY MEDICAL



A career preparation program designed to provide related instruction and practical experience.



## WHAT DOES THE PROGRAM PREPARE ME TO DO?

Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) are skilled medical workers who respond by ambulance to medical emergencies for the injured and ill. They are sent to emergencies by specially trained dispatchers who maintain radio contact or patch them through to medical professionals for on-going instructions. Following instructions, they examine victims to determine the nature and extent of injury or illness and give emergency basic life support (BLS), such as giving oxygen and doing cardiopulmonary resuscitation (heart/lung revival). They continue the BLS treatment during transport to hospitals. They help the emergency room staff do pre-admittance treatment and obtain medical history.

EMTs are trained on ambulance operations and procedures. They drive emergency vehicles with special communication and medical equipment. They check their vehicles daily and keep them in top notch condition and well stocked with medical supplies.

This one semester course includes classroom and ride along experience. It meets all state requirements for certification through Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Authority. Students become CPR/EMT certified.

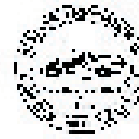

## EMPLOYMENT OUTLOOK

Turnover for this occupational field is high. This is mainly due to the unusual work hours and the stress brought on by constantly working in a crisis environment.

Most EMTs and paramedics work for private ambulance companies. Some EMTs find employment in the hospital setting as Emergency Room Technicians (ER Tech.). For most fire departments EMT-Is are required to test for employment.

Recent surveys show that there is more demand for paramedics because of their advanced training and

- ❖ Minimum age - 18 years old by the completion of the EMT course
- ❖ Use good judgment and discretion
- ❖ Good physical condition, requires a variety of positions and bending
- ❖ Ability to follow directions and carry out sequences of activities
- ❖ Perform tasks using fine motor skills
- ❖ Accuracy and attention to detail is essential
- ❖ Conform to dress standards and conduct regulations of the class
- ❖ Good personal hygiene and grooming habits
- ❖ Understand and carry out health and safety standards
