# VOCATIONAL NURSING

*We provide relevant and rigorous technical education that prepares students for career and college.*

**PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Must be at least 18 years of age.
2. Must possess a High School Diploma, GED, or Equivalency Diploma.
3. Proof of negative Tuberculosis immunization or chest X-ray.
4. Proof of immunizations (MMRV, T-dap, Varicella) and Hep B vaccinations or Titers.
5. Receive a passing score of 80% or higher on the Admissions Assessment Exam.
6. Live Scan: Submission of electronic fingerprints to the California Department of Justice (DOJ) and Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) for a local, state, and federal criminal record search.
7. Drug screen clearance.
8. Complete and return VN Admissions packet.

**STUDENT SELECTION PROCESS:**

1. Please call 909-947-3400 for more information or to schedule an Admissions Assessment Exam.
2. Fill out the BVROP Adult Application and Questionnaire.
3. Receive a passing score of 80% or higher on the Admissions Assessment Exam .
4. Schedule a Financial Aid appointment and receive the VN Admissions packet.
5. Sign Enrollment Agreement and pay Registration Fee upon confirmation of secured program funding and submission of admission requirements.
6. Meet with Director of Vocational Nursing.
7. Attend a mandatory orientation and submit applicable payment.

Students prepare for licensure as a Vocational Nurse in California and learn basic concepts in pharmacology, nutrition, psychology, anatomy, physiology, medical-surgical nursing, care of mother and her newborn, normal growth and development, and concepts of leadership for healthcare.



Baldy View ROP’s Vocational Nursing program trains students to provide nursing care for the sick, injured, and otherwise disabled health patients. Instructors utilize a blend of learning methodology that includes classroom instruction, laboratory simulations on site in the BVROP state-of-the-art LVN Skills Lab, externships in clinical settings, ATI e-learning practice modules, and NCLEX exam preparation. Traditional prerequisites are not required for program admission. The program is designed to prepare students to meet all legal requirements for licensure as a Licensed Vocational Nurse in California. Upon successfully completing the program students will receive a Diploma in Vocational Nursing and are eligible to sit for the National Council of Licensure Examination (NCLEX-PN). Baldy View ROP’s Vocational Nursing program is accredited by the Board of Vocational Nursing and Psychiatric Technicians (BVNPT) and the Council on Occupational Education (COE).

Admissions Assessment Exam Applicants need 80% on each assessment to pass (a minimum of 40 out of 50 points).

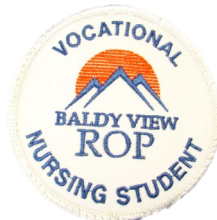
They may take the Admissions Assessment a maximum of two (2) times.
